Martin Brändl untersucht die paulinischen Metaphern, Anspielungen und Fachausdrücke aus dem Kontext der antiken Athletik, Gymnastik und Agonistik und zeigt, dass Paulus in der antiken Agon-Tradition eine besondere Stellung zukommt. Seine Metaphern verdanken ihr Profil der Anlehnung an alttestamentliche und frühjüdische Traditionen, in denen sich die agonistischen Metaphern schon vor Paulus fest mit der Tradition vom Leiden des Gerechten verbunden hatten. Paulus verwendet agonistische Metaphern auch in Anspielung auf örtliche Gegebenheiten. Der Autor zeigt anhand 1. Korinther 9,24-27, dass der Apostel hier Metaphern in Anspielung auf das Lokalkolorit der Isthmischen Spiele formuliert, die alle zwei Jahre in der unmittelbaren Nähe von Korinth stattfanden.

Feature film has done more than any other medium to shape the image of Martin

Luther held by the common public in the 20th century. Luther films have always - apart from the very earliest - been ambitious undertakings, staffed by personnel that include leading representatives of theology and expert consultants in ecclesiastical history. Nonetheless, the Luther film has been largely bypassed by traditional Luther scholarship. The status of the historic figure as a national myth in Germany and a Church founder in America required a cinematic concept that was closely linked with theological issues as well as the self-image of the Lutheran Church. The present study is chiefly concerned with working out the interests brought to bear on each film project by its initiators and the impact each has made on the image of Luther in film in its historical context. There is no other medium that allows for a clearer reading of the history of the change in the Lutheran mindset during the past century than in film. This mass medium shows how scholarship, whether in respect to psychology or the interpretation of the Reformation as a media reformation, was popularized. Moreover, the film fairly consistently sticks to the positive image of the hero. Whereas the view of Luther in German films increasingly emphasized the nationalist element until 1927, since 1953 the Anglo-American tradition has placed the emphasis on the element of liberation from conventional thinking, and from the authorities of the Middle Ages as well as on new beginnings. That was the image that became the basis for all later filmic representation. Therefore it is legitimate to speak of an Americanization of Luther in film. Some main aspects of Luther's image can be seen in both the European and the American traditions. Moreover, viewer response to the Luther film has shown itself to be an indicator of the degree of secularisation in a society. It also shows whether and if so, how strongly, links to a particular religious affiliation are perceived at a given time.

Warum lehnt das Christentum die gleichgeschlechtliche Sexualität so hartnäckig ab? Die Bibel antwortet auf diese Frage keineswegs eindeutig. Den Schlüssel für die Erklärung liefern vielmehr die apokryphen und jüdisch-hellenistischen Schriften aus dem Umfeld des Neuen Testaments. In einer von der Queer Theorie inspirierten Anamnese der jüdisch-christlichen Religionsgeschichte deutet der Autor die Verurteilung gleichgeschlechtlicher Sexualität als Symptom einer fundamentalen Krankheit des Christentums. Dieser kommt ein zentraler Stellenwert im Imaginären des christlichen Symbolsystems zu: ohne Sodom kein Evangelium.

Bastian Scholz legt die erste diachrone, konfessionsvergleichende Analyse der

staatspolitischen Haltungen beider christlicher Großkirchen in Deutschland vor. Er erörtert ihren Einfluss auf die Stabilität der politischen Systeme des 19., 20. und 21. Jahrhunderts sowie ihre Rolle während der staatlichen Umbrüche. Für Deutschlands Geschichte war die konfessionelle Spaltung der Bevölkerung ebenso schicksalhaft wie die Vielzahl von Systemtransformationen. Die katholische Kirche pflegte nach 1803 allgemeine Staatsdistanz, war opportunistische wie risikoscheue Wegbereiterin des Verfassungsstaates. Erst im Vaticanum II 1962-65 bekannte sie sich zur Demokratie. Die evangelische Kirche opponierte in Deutschland lange gegen die Demokratisierung und idealisierte die Monarchie bis zur Kirchenspaltung durch Hitler. Mit der Bundesrepublik erwies sich nur jenes System als stabil, das frühzeitig die Loyalität beider Konfessionen genoss.

Sodom als Symptom

The Interpretation of the Bible

This unique volume, nearly 2000 pages in length and handsomely printed on Bible paper, is perhaps the most comprehensive scholarly work of our time on the translation and interpretation of the Bible. At its core are papers presented to an international symposium in Ljubljana in September 1996 to mark the publication of the new Slovenian version of the Bible, a landmark in Slovene identity and cultural life. In addition, its distinguished editor, Joze Krasovec, has commissioned a wide range of contributions devoted to translations of the Bible in many languages, including the Slavonic languages, Croatian, Czech, Hungarian, Polish and the Scandinavian languages. The 82 chapters in this work, mostly in English, are divided into three parts. Part I, on ancient translations and hermeneutics of the Bible, contains contributions by M.-E. Boismard, S.P. Brock, K.J. Cathcart, R.P. Gordon, L.J. Grech, M. Hengel, O. Keel, J. Lust, E. Tov and others, with a notable comprehensive bibliographic survey of oriental Bible translations from the first millennium by M. van Esbroeck. Part II, on Slavonic and other translations of the Bible, includes the first detailed study of the history of the Slavonic Bible, by Francis J. Thomson (over 300 pp.). Part III, with essays by such scholars as J.H. Charlesworth, D.J.A. Clines, J. Gnllka, M. G÷rg, N. Lohfink and A.C. Thiselton, concerns the interpretation of the Bible in translation, philosophy, theology, art and music. In an appendix, a complete list of printed Bibles in languages throughout the world is presented for the first time.
