On November 23, 1887, white vigilantes gunned down unarmed black laborers and their families during a spree lasting more than two hours. The violence erupted due to strikes on Louisiana sugar cane plantations. Fear, rumor and white supremacist ideals clashed with an unprecedented labor action to create an epic tragedy. A future member of the U.S. House of Representatives was among the leaders of a mob that routed black men from houses and forced them to a stretch of railroad track, ordering them to run for their

lives before gunning them down. According to a witness, the guns firing in the black neighborhoods sounded like a battle. Author and award-winning reporter John DeSantis uses correspondence, interviews and federal records to detail this harrowing true story.

Hypolite Chauvin (ca. 1788-1856) was born in St. Charles, Louisiana and died in Houma, Louisiana. He was married in 1807 to Tarsile Marie LeBlanc. Ancestry is traced to Pierre Chauvin (ca. 1631-1699) who was born at Solesme, France and died in Montreal, Canada. Descendants lived in Louisiana, Texas, and elsewhere.
