If You Lived At The Time Of The American Revolution

This book addresses the effect on the jury of a number of small, seemingly isolated changes in the

composition of the jury, the interpretation of the Constitution and laws governing the jury, and the relationship between judge and jury. It argues that the cumulative effect of these changes is a significant decline in the civil jury's use and function. While the book acknowledges that there are understandable reasons why these changes have occurred, it urges that we step back from the headlong rush to jury "reform" and consider what we have done to the jury. Some changes that have occurred may be salutary, but others are surely detrimental to this Constitutional right with nearly 1000 years of history. The book first examines historical and contemporary justifications for the civil jury, then looks at the jury's history extending back to Norman England. It then details significant twentieth-century changes in the jury's milieu that make it more difficult for the jury to function. The result of these changes is that while the jury is nominally more available than it was in eighteenth-century England, it is also more controlled, as judges have more opportunities to take cases from the jury and decide them themselves, and more opportunities to shape the jury's verdict. This book will be of particular interest to teachers of law, history, and political science; to lawyers; and to policy-makers at both the state and federal level. General readers interested in this important governmental institution will also find it interesting.

Spoken language communication is arguably the most important activity that distinguishes humans from nonhuman species. While many animal species communicate and exchange information using sound, humans are unique in the complexity of the information that can be conveyed using speech, and in the range of ideas, thoughts and emotions that can be expressed. communication for the entire structure of human society, there are many aspects of this process that are not fully understood. One problem is that research on speech and language is typically carried out by different groups of scientists working on separate aspects of the underlying functional and neural systems. On the other hand, research from psycholinguistic perspectives examines the processes by which representations of meaning are extracted from the acoustic-phonetic sequence, and how these are linked to the construction of higher-level linguistic interpretation in terms of sentences and discourse. Till now, there has been relatively little interaction between speech researchers from these two groups, in spite of a dramatic expansion in recent years of research into the neural bases of auditory and linguistic functions. This book bridges the gap between these two lines of research, recognising that both have the same aims in understanding how the motor gestures of a speaker are transformed to sounds and how those are mapped onto meaning in the comprehension of spoken language. It presents the work of leading researchers specializing in a wide range of topics within speech perception and language processing - along with contributions from key researchers in neuroanatomy and neuro-imaging. This important new work cuts through the traditional boundaries and fosters crossdisciplinary interactions in this important and rapidly developing area of the biological and cognitive sciences.

Much of the chemical products and waste products of modern society are released into the environment either during production, storage, transport, use or ultimate disposal. These released materials participate in natural cycles and reactions and frequently lead to interference and disturbance of natural systems.

Oliver Wendell Holmes Sr., (1809-1894) was a physician by profession but achieved fame as a writer. He was one of the best regarded American poets of the 19th century. In 1833 Holmes attended the famed Ecole de Medecine in Paris. He pursued his medical studies in the Parisian hospital system. He first attained national prominence with his poem Old Ironsides. One of his most popular works was The Autocrat of the Breakfast Table (1857). He was one of the five members of the group known as the Fireside Poets. He contributed poems and essays to the Atlantic Monthly from its inception, and also published novels. Holmes is also known for his writing of several beautiful hymns. In 1846, Holmes coined the word anesthesia. He also developed the popular model of the stereoscope. Amongst his other works are Elsie Venner (1861), The Guardian Angel (1867), The Poet at the Breakfast-Table (1872), John Lothrop Motley: A Memoir (1879), Medical Essays (1883), A Mortal Antipathy: First Opening of the New Portfolio (1885) and Over the Teacups (1891).
